

The SEEK License Agreement: Purposes and Pointers

The **purposes** of the SEEK License Agreement are:

1. To help ensure that the SEEK model is implemented as intended.
2. To obtain annual feedback from those implementing SEEK. This helps us improve the approach.
3. To protect the SEEK copyrighted materials. The SEEK Parent Handouts however *should* be customized with information on local resources.
4. To help us track where the SEEK model is being implemented.
5. To obtain modest fees from large practices and healthcare systems to help disseminate the SEEK model.

Here are a few **pointers** to help complete this Agreement:

- Article 2: Enter the number of primary care professionals (MDs, DOs, NPs, PAs) who will be implementing SEEK.
- 3.2(a): Enter the state(s) where SEEK will be implemented. “Qualified sublicensees” refers to affiliated practices or clinics where SEEK will be implemented. It does *not* include different sites of the same practice.
- 3.2(b): Note the practice(s) information to be provided to the SEEK Project.
- 4.1: Feedback is required every 12 months during the 3-year term of the Agreement.
